## Must One Be a Member of the church of Christ?

How many churches did Jesus establish? The Bible answers, *ONE!* Jesus used the word church (singular), not churches (plural), when He promised, *I will build my church* (Matt 16:18). Using the words church and body interchangeably, Paul wrote, *Christ is the head of the church: and he is the savior of the body* (Eph. 5:23). In fact, according to Paul, the church is the body (Eph. 1:22- 23; Cot. 1:18). Furthermore, Paul declared, *There is one body* (Eph. 4:4). It just stands to reason that if the church is the body; and, if there is only one body; then there is only one church, which is Christ's.

Must one be a member of the church of Christ if he is saved? The Bible answers, **YES!** All the saved will have been redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ, **(Col.** 

1:14; Heb. 9:22). Paul said the church is that which he that purchased with His own blood (Acts 20:28). The church is the body (Eph. 1:22-23). Christ is the savior of the body (Eph. 5:23). Christ, loved the church, and gave himself for it, (Eph. 5:25). Acts 2:47 says, And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. One must be a member of the church of Christ if he is saved I because the church is the saved! Since the establishment of His church in **Acts 2** (the first Pentecost after Christ's resurrection), it cannot be shown from the Bible that anyone has been saved outside the Lord's church.

The church of Christ is God's family (Eph. 3:14-15). Paul called the church the house of God (1 Tim. 3:15). In order for one to be saved, he must be a child of God (Rom. 8:14-17). Remember, the saved are God's children, and the church is God's family. Question: Does God have children outside His family (the church)? If one is saved (a child of God), but not in God's family (the church), then God is the Father of children outside His family. No one should make such an accusation against God! But, that is what one is doing if he says people can be saved without being a member of the Lord's church. God has no children outside His family. All of God's children are in His family; therefore, all as God's children are in His church. Since God has no children outside His family, and since the church is His family, only those in the church of Christ will be saved.

The word church means the called out. One is

called out by the gospel of Christ (2 Thess. 2:14). One accepts that call and is saved when he believes and obeys that gospel (2 Thess. 1:6-9; Heb. 5:8-9). But notice Colossians 3:15, ...ye are called in one body. Colossians 1:18 shows the body to be the church; therefore, those who are called are called in **one church**. If the church is the *called out*, as ekklesia means, then the church is the saved. Those not in the church (the called out) are walking in darkness (lost), (1 Pet. 2:9).

No one can be saved unless he is reconciled unto God (Rom. 5:10; Heb. 2:17). Sin separates a man from God (Isa. 59:1-2). Severed, separated from God, man is hopelessly lost (Eph. 2:12). Through the blood of Christ, one may be reconciled (2 Cor. 5:17-21), and made nigh unto God (Eph. 2:13). (By the way, the blood that reconciles one to God is the blood that purchased the church.) Ephesians 2:16 establishes that those reconciled unto God are reconciled in one body. The one body is the one church (Cot. 1:18); therefore, those reconciled unto God are reconciled in one church. Those outside the church of Christ have not been reconciled unto God.

THINK! THINK! THINK! What sort of church would the Lord's church be if every member were just like me?
