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Church: The Household Of God By Mark T. Nevins

This is the second article in a series of articles on the church which came into existence on the day of Pentecost in Acts 2. The New Testament uses various descriptive phrases to describe the Lord's church and to emphasize a particular aspect of it. This study focuses on the description of a "household." All Scriptures guoted are from the New King James Version unless otherwise specified.

When one thinks about a household, he may think of a house where the family lives and interacts with each other. In Acts 10:2 one reads about Cornelius and his house. Cornelius was, "a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, who gave alms generously to the people, and praved to God always". Another example of a household is seen when we read about Noah's preparation of the ark, "By faith Noah, being

Therefore we are members of the "house of God," which is built on the foundation of Jesus Christ.

> In the physical household, you have those in authority (father, mother) and those that are subject to that authority (children). This same feature is true within God's family, the church. God is the Father of the church. In Ephesians 3:14 Paul writes, "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ." Again in Ephesians 4:6, "one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all". Jesus in His ministry states in Matthew 23:9, "Do not call anyone on earth your father; for One is your Father. He who is in heaven". In Colossians 1:18 one reads that Christ is the head of the

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
