Christian Scientism as a religious doctrine and the Chris- diculous doctrine! tian Science faith originated with Mary Baker Glover Patterson Eddy.

Christian Science's standard of authority is "Science and Health with key to the Scriptures", which sets forth the system for which Mrs. Eddy claims "Divine Revelations".

"In the year 1866, I discovered the Christ Science or divine laws of life, truth, and love, and named my discovme during many years for the reception of this final revelation of the absolute divine principle of scientific mental healing (S.H., p. 107:1-6). She claims to have received the teaching of science and health from God.

There is a curse placed on anyone, including an angel that preaches another gospel (Galatians 1:8-9). Jude tells us that "THE FAITH", the gospel, has ONCE FOR ALL been delivered to the saints (Jude 3). Mrs. Eddy refers to them as her thoughts and to herself as the author (S.H., p. 114:30-31; 123:16-17; 130:23; 152:5; 153:5), and refers to herself as having healed or cured by its practice (S.H., p. 149:22-25; 162:17-25).

Christian Science says, "There is no sin." "A sinner is not reformed merely by assuring himself that he cannot be a sinner because there is no sin. To put down the claim of sin, you must detect it, remove the mask, point out the illusion . . . and so prove its unreality" (S.H., p. 447:22-27). "Man is incapable of sin . . . " (S.H., p. 475:28). This teaching of "Science and Health" if true would cause the Bible to appear ridiculous in such verses as "Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body" (Romans 6:12). "Be ye angry and sin not..." (Ephesians 4:26). "... For whatsoever is not of faith is sin" (Romans 14:23). "For all have sinned, not in us ... If we say we have not sinned we make Him a

Now, let's look at the Christian Science teachings. liar and His word is not in us" (1 John 1:8-10). What a ri-

The Christian Science view on Christ is that He is not God, He is not the Christ, and He was not capable of reconciling fallen mankind to Jehovah God. ". . . The Christian believes that Christ is God. Jesus Christ is not God." (S.H., p. 361:1-2, 12). Hebrews 1:8 says differently. The Christian Science faith would contradict the Bible and make it a lie. They go and say "One sacrifice, however great, is insufficient to pay the debt of sin" (S.H., p. 23:3-4). They need ery Christian Science. God had been graciously preparing to read God's word again! The Bible clearly refutes their false teaching (1 Peter 1:18-19; Hebrews 9:12; Hebrews 9:27-28).

> "Science and Health" denies that death is experienced. "Life is real, and death is the illusion" (S.H., p. 584:9-16). The Bible over seven hundred times uses the word "dead" or "death" in passages concerning mankind's experiences and some tense of "die" over five hundred times as in "And as it is appointed unto men once to die ..." (Hebrews 9:27).

> Concerning the judgment, Christian Science teaching is: "No final judgment awaits mortals . . . " (S.H., p. 291:28-32). Again, they need to stop and think on these passages (Hebrews 9:27: 2 Corinthians 5:10: Romans 14:10). Whom shall we believe the inspired writers of the Bible or the authors of Science and Health?

The teaching of Christian Scientism says Jesus' death on the cross did not occur. "Jesus' students, not sufficiently advanced fully to understand their master's triumph, did not perform many wonderful works, until they saw him after his crucifixion and learned that he had not died" (S.H., p. 45:32; 46:1-3). In our society, we are used to people "getting away" pented nor have been forgiven! with certain things, aren't we? "And as buying it; or someone taking extra time on their breaks at work and getting paid for it. Perhaps someone we know has been dishonest (lying), and yet men tend to ignore this sin. It seems that we have reared a society which thinks that we can escape certain sins by ignoring them and no

God says there are things we cannot escape in this life no matter how hard we try! Just like Adam and Eve could Lord returns! not escape God (Gen. 3:7-10); just like Jonah could not escape God (Jonah 1:3-17, ch. 2); neither can we escape God (Prov. 15:3; Heb. 4:13; Ecc. 12:14; Rom. 2:16)! Nor can we escape the truth He has revealed.

We Cannot Escape The Consequences Of Sin.

We have reared a society of people who are under the impression that they can "bury" their sins deep enough that no one will find out about them. Sometimes, folks have the idea that they can somehow escape the consequences of sin if they pay enough money, run far enough away, deny it, or whatever. In truth, this is not possible! "Be sure your sin will find you out" (Num. 32:23)! We need to understand that independently of Christ and His shed blood (Rom. 6:3-6), we cannot escape sin (Acts 2:38, **22:16)!** Whether we are looking at this from the aspect of the physical or the spiritual consequences of sin, we cannot escape this without Christ! Lest we forget, go back and read Romans 6:23, which tells us, "the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." In addition to this, God compares physical sowing and reaping with spiritual sowing and reaping in **Galatians 6:7-8**. Be sure, there will be a "bitter harvest" awaiting us if we have sown a life of sin and have not re-

We Cannot Escape Death.

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BAPTISM - URGENT AND ESSENTIAL By David Riggs

In New Testament times people were baptized as soon cleansed. as they heard the gospel and had faith in Christ (Acts 2:41: 8:35-39: 16:30-34). There were no postponements or delays; there was no such thing as waiting for a "baptismal day." It was always "straightway," "the same day," "the same hour of the night," etc. They thought baptism was urgent and essential.

Furthermore, the inspired men of the New Testament did not take baptism lightly. They never poked fun at it saving, "There's no power in the water," neither did they accuse some of trusting in "water salvation." They taught that Jesus made atonement for sin in His death, and they commanded all to believe, repent, and be baptized in orviewed baptism as an act of faith in and submission to -20).

All would freely admit that there is no power in the water of baptism. The power is of the Lord. Jesus healed a blind man by anointing his eyes and saying, "Go wash in the pool of Siloam."
